NORMAL VOLUNTEERING HOURS: BETWEEN 9.30AM - 4.30PM

Volunteering in the workshop means working alongside the whole LWR team - working together with the retail and collection team to bring to life the reclaimed timber we collect.

You will never be left on your own and one of workshop staff will be the person responsible for teaching you throughout your induction, though you will learn from all the staff and volunteers here as we are a close-knit team.

You will need to be learn and follow our H&S procedures. We will teach you the relevant modules on your induction and teach you how to use the relevant tools safely and efficiently.

WHAT YOUR ROLE WILL ENTAIL:

- Preparing our recycled wood for reuse in our workshop - this involves denailing, sawing off damaged ends, removing metalwork from timber
- Learning to use small hand tools and perhaps some power tools, as you progress
- Cutting timber to appropriate approximate sizes for further reuse by our woodworkers
- Finishing products made by our woodwork team - this involves sanding and oiling products made in our workshop
- Keeping the workshop clean, safe and tidy alongside everyone else at Leeds Wood Recycling
- Reorganising parts of the shop
- 'Mucking in' with the woodworking needs of our Social Enterprise - this may be helping the collections teams unload the van, finding certain woods for customers, pricing up timbers etc
- Helping with the online shop orders
